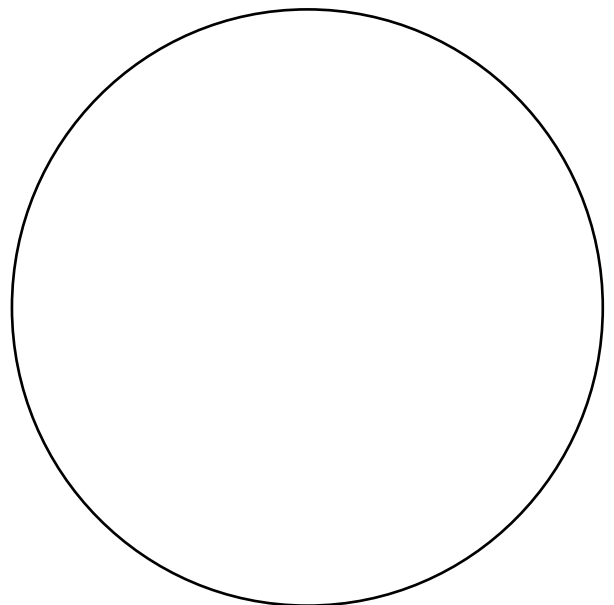
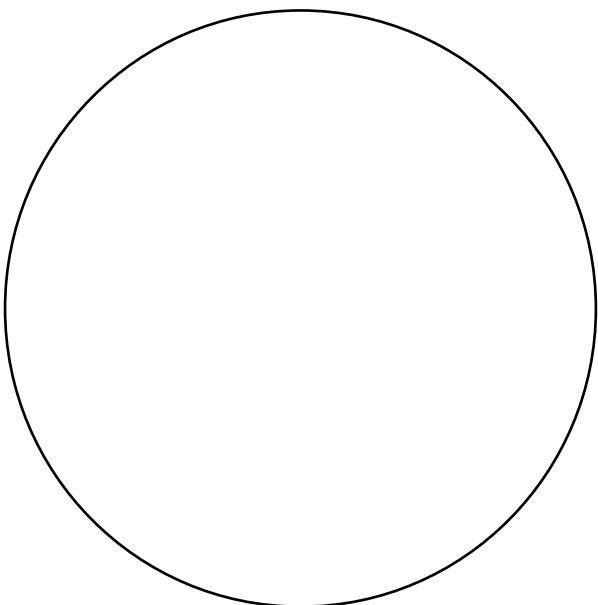
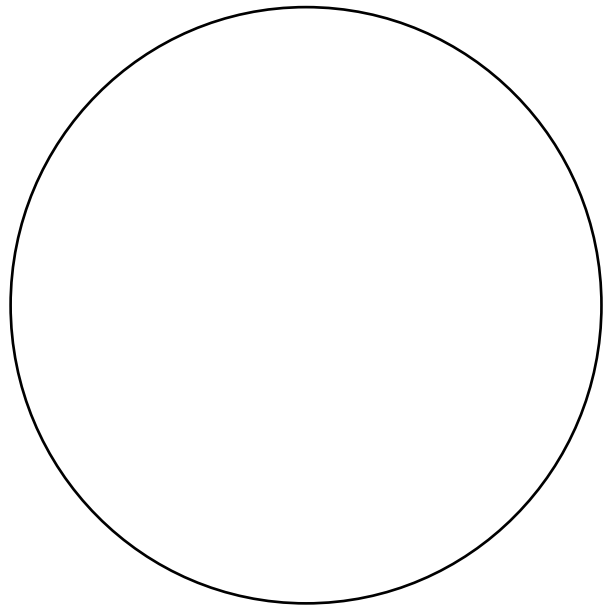
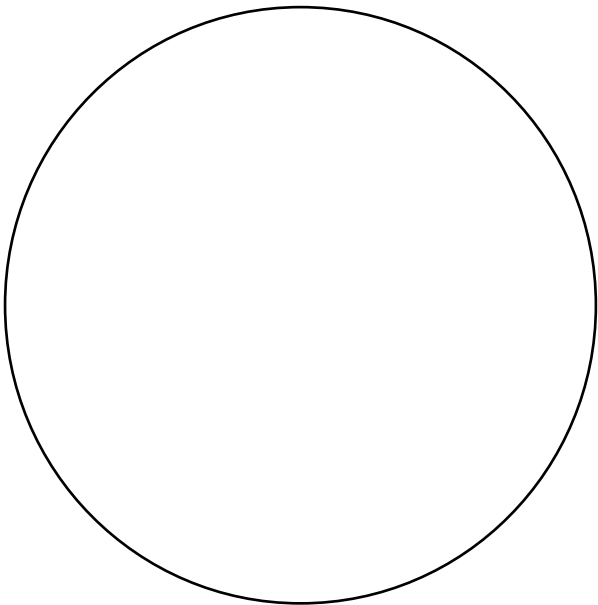
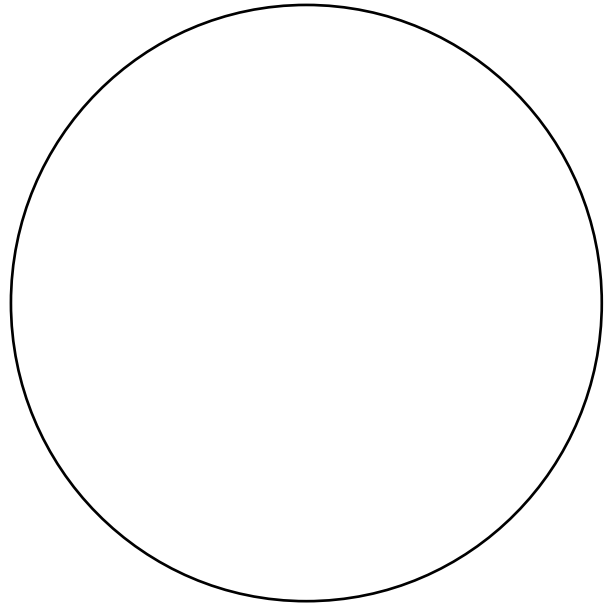
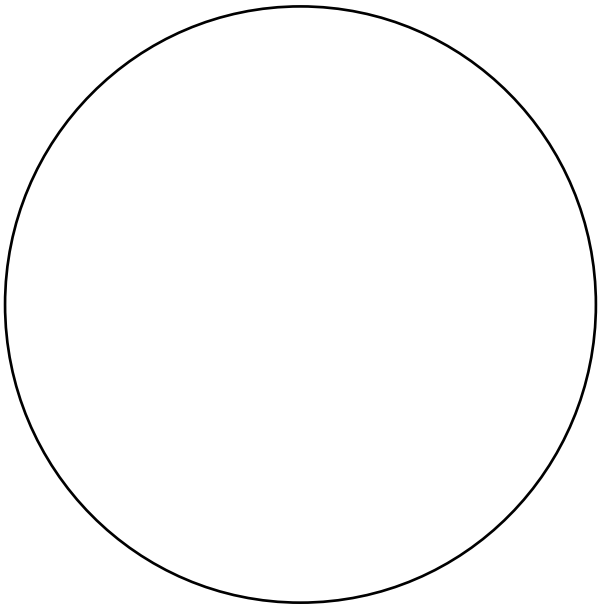


Fractions Fun



Can you decorate these circles? You could turn them into cakes or pizzas, maybe. Then cut them out and fold and cut them into these fractions and stick them to some paper or into a school book.

Can you make:

1. 1 whole
2. $\frac{1}{2}$ (half)
3. $\frac{1}{4}$ (one quarter)
4. $\frac{3}{4}$ (three-quarters)
5. $\frac{2}{8}$ (What is that the same as?)
6. $\frac{6}{8}$ (What is that the same as?)

Don't forget, every piece needs to be equal in size.

If you have finished all of these, why not get some containers or plastic bottles and see if you can fill them up $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{3}{4}$ and full to the top (1 whole).
